In 2004, our founder Kimberly Goreham, was forced to flee her home in San Diego, California in the middle of the night, with a 50 foot wall of flames surrounding them. Driving for their lives down a two-lane highway with her young children in the back seat, Kimberly suddenly understood the importance of preparing for the unexpected. The fear and panic the family felt would have been minimized with an evacuation plan. Lives would have been saved that night with a little bit of advanced community planning and teamwork. This is the CORE of our WHY. We believe disasters don't have to hurt so much and preparation is the key. We're here to help, from the heart.


RECOVERY

\$44 Million dollars in unsolicited donations were distributed by hundreds of our organized volunteers. Our efforts to help rebuild communities continue today.




The relationships we've made are solid, supportive and greatly valued. Disasters have a way of bonding people together and bringing out the best in each of us.




After the 1995 earthquake in Kobe, Japan, an estimated 60 to 90 percent of people trapped in the rubble of collapsed buildings were rescued by locals before emergency aid arrived.



FOR EVERY \$1 DOLLAR SPENT ON DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AN AVERAGE OF \$4 DOLLARS IS SAVED ON RESPONSE AND RECOVERY

According to the Giovanni Zambello of the Finnish Red Cross



- Hurricane Irma COST 64.76 BILLION in DAMAGES to land and property. (Still rebuilding)
- Hurricane Harvey COST 125 BILLION in DAMAGES to land and property. (Still rebuilding)
- California Wildfires COST 13.028 BILLION in DAMAGES to land and property. (Still rebuilding)
- In 2017 United States will spend over **306 BILLION** in disaster-related recovery. (Too much!)
